Your comments:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Worked well behind the plate with ear on corner, good stance, voice and signals</li> <li>• Moved well on WP/PB’s to get position for possible calls.</li> <li>• Made a good call on play at the plate.</li> <li>• On swinging strikes, simply use the hammer with no verbal call. On checked swing strikes us “Swing” so the batter knows you called it a strike.</li> <li>• You cannot overrule your partner. The calling umpire determines the course of action. You only respond if requested by the calling umpire for more information. If a coach approaches you about a partner’s call, send the coach to speak to the calling umpire and offer no opinion to the coach.</li> <li>• On bases good parallel movement to the baselines to get position</li> </ul>
