Your comments:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Good parallel movement along the basepaths on SB attempts • BU seldom sees nice plays in OF because heading inside and watching runners • Good adjustments to the starting position pointers provided, especially with R2 or R3 • BU – good job watching runners touch bases • PU – good job warning and enforcing on illegal pitches; when an illegal pitch is hit, remember that the offence has an option; also use voice and body to let both teams know that illegal pitch was called, and the out is nullified
Suggestions for improvement:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Indicator in LH – good job making the adjustment • Remember starting positions on the bases: One step in foul territory with no runners; R2, set up behind SS • Ball out, umpire in immediately all the time – can't watch the fly ball and then move later • Safe calls on bases, stand up straight, and make signal from shoulders – don't hunch over on calls • Strike signals – don't hunch, stand up, good high hammer • Batted balls, out from behind catcher, mask off, trail B-R to 1B • PU – setting up over top of catcher; work on moving into the slot
